- Here are a few harmful chemicals found in cigarettes:

- Cadmium (found in batteries)
- Butane (in Lighter fluid)
- Nicotine (used in pesticides)
- Carbon Monoxide
- Ammonia (used in toilet bowl cleaner)
- Methanol (used in rocket fuel)
- Arsenic (used in rat poison)
- Hydrogen Cyanide
- Tar

- Tar Causes cancer of the lungs mouth and throat

- A carcinogen is a cancer causing substance

- There are 43 known carcinogens in cigarettes

- Nicotine is the addictive substance found in tobacco products

- Cigarette smoking kills over 480,000 Americans a year
